South Carolina Grenville District, I know all men by these presents that I Elias Earle of the District & State afores<sup>d</sup> for & in consideration of four hundred dollars to me paid by Elliott Clardy of Pendleton district & State afores<sup>d</sup> Have granted bargained & sold unto the said Clardy a certain tract of Land containing three hundred acres more or less. Laying on the beaverdam Creek of Enoe. Where Harry Brock now lives it being part of a tract of Land Surveyed for John Anderson. & Granted to Francis Brumar & Ephraim Mitchell as Tenants in common & Conveyed to Elias Earle as by reference of the deed will more fully appear. Begining on a red oak corner & running a straight line to a black Gum at the bridge over the Creek on the road thence down the Creek to a conditional line made by Elias Earle & Thos. Springfield thence running an east course to a dead oak on Thos. Hookers spring branch thence up the main Spring branch to bear thence an east course to the back line thence S. W. 54 to a chestnut corner thence west 87 chain to a black oak thence north east 15. 30. 00 to a red oak thence N. W. 15 de. 20. chain 6. links to the beginning red oak corner. As by reference to the Grant will more fully appear & Including the land and premises within the course with all waters & water courses timber & profits & Enclosures. Or any part thereof.
