


This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & four between Rob^t Cox of the one part & John Cox of the other part both of the State of South Carolina District of Greenville Witnesseth that the s^d Rob^t Cox for & in consideration of the sum of four hundred & fifty dollars to him in hand well and truly paid at & before the signing & delivering of these presents hath bargained & sold & by Value of these presents doth bargain Grant & sell to the above s^d John Cox a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation two hundred acres more or less being a part of a tract of Land Originally Granted to George Salton or by his ^{son} Elizey Williams Moultrie in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three having the following lines & boundaries Beginning at a stake on Mr Ford's old line near his Spring house thence along Ford's line S. E. till it joins Sammons line thence along said S. E. till it intersects with Archabald Cox's line thence along said Cox's line N. till it strikes W. M. Cox's Gum corner thence N. W. to the rock Spring thence N. W. to the Beginning Corner the above s^d John Cox his heirs assigns To have & to hold the above s^d Land & premises with all woods & waters houses orchards gardens and everything in any wise thunto belonging forever from the above s^d Rob^t Cox his heirs and assigns & from all & every other person or persons from having or laying any just right title or claim thereon In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal day & date above written - Signed sealed & Delivered in the presents of us

In the consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by James Ayres of aforesaid State & District. Have Granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell & release unto the said James Ayres all that tract or parcel of Land containing sixty seven Acres, be the same more or less. Beginning on a stake running N. 22. E. 32. to a stake thence N. 68. W. 30 to a stake thence S. 27. E. 7 to a red Oak thence S. 16. E. 20. to a post Oak thence S. 50. E. 16. to the Beginning, with all & singular the premises the rights members hereditaments & Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^d James Ayres his heirs & assigns forever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators To warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said James Ayres his heirs & against my self my heirs & against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. -
