District of Greenville have granted bargained sold & released & By these presents do Grant & re-
gain sell & release unto the s^r Jessie Kirby all that part of a tract of land containing
one hundred & twenty five acres Being part of a tract of land originally granted
unto Athel Marks on mountain Creek waters of Saluda river. The said tract
& Beginning near a Road on a post oak 3^t thence N. 60° 33'. E. to a stake on the Original
line thence S. 40° E. 27. 30 to stake at thence N. 58° E. 48. 50 to hickory 3^t thence N. 40°
W. 23. 80 Stake at on old line thence N. 52° W. 15. 50 to R. O. at old mark thence N. 85°
W. 4. C. to the Beginning corner P. O. 84. Containing one hundred & twenty five acres
more or less. Together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
appurtenances thereto premises. Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^r Jessie Kirby
his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & adm^rs.
to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the s^r Jessie Kirby
his heirs & assigns Against myself my heirs & assigns and Against every Person or
Persons whom ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof -
Likewise I Anna Waldron wife to s^r Joseph Waldron do affix to all my right and
title of said above mentioned land unto the s^r Jessie Kirby the same being for value recd.
