


E. 40. 27 Ch. to a stake 37 thence N. E. 58° 48' 50. to a hickory 37 thence N. 40. W. 23. 82 to a stake on the old line thence S. 52. W. 15. 50. to a red oak 37 old mark thence S. W. 35. 4 Ch. to the Beginning Post Oak 37 -
