 unto the said John Westfield all that tract or parcels of Lands lying and being in the  
 District and State aforesaid and on branches of Saluda River the same being Eighty two  
 Acres more or less, a part of a tract containing Eight hundred and Eighty originally  
 granted to James Blasingame on the seventh of August Seventeen hundred & Eighty Six  
 and the Eighty two Acres, more to be conveyed runs as follows Beginning on a white  
 Oak stump three running N. 13. W. 34. Chain to a post oak + thence S. 67. W. 25 Chain 50  
 to a Post Oak + thence S. 7. E. 19. Chain 40. to Sawwoods + on Thomas Jones line thence in  
 S 88. E. 10. Chain to a stake + thence S. 17. E. 18. Chain 40 to a stake + thence N. 42 E. 17.  
 Chain 90 to the Beginning. Together with all and a singular the Rights, members  
 Tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or  
 appertaining. To Have and to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
 the said John Westfield his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defende all & singular  
 the said premises unto the said John Westfield his heirs & assigns against myself and  
 my heirs and all and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or  
 any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this Eighteenth day of  
 May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five and in  
 the twenty ninth and thirtieth year of the sovereignty and Independence of the  
 United States of America - Signed Sealed and Delivered in
