 sold & released, and by these presents DO Grant bargain, sell & release unto
 the said William Robertson all that Lot or parcel of land whereon the said W^m
 Robertson now lives in the village of Pleasantburgh, and being the one half
 of two certain lots of land known & distinguished in the chart of said village
 by the numbers 34 & 35. Having been conveyed from Sam^l G. Alston to John
 McBeth from McBeth to Jesse Goodlett & from Goodlett to me
 Beginning at a stake corner at the corner of the street opposite to Alstons Shop,
 running thence S 15^o 2' W. seventy feet to a stake, thence N 74^o 2' W. two hundred and thirty
 five feet to a stake, thence N 15^o 2' E. seventy feet to a stake, thence S 74^o 2' E. two hundred
 and thirty five feet to the beginning - supposed to contain one half acre be the same
 more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident
 or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said William Robertson his heirs & assigns forever
