South Carolina I know all manner by these presents that I Edwards Watson Greenville District of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Joseph M. Cool of the same State and district above Bargained sold and Relased & by these presents unto Do Bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph M. Cool parcel of land part of a tract Surveyed by the said Edwards Watson & Joseph M. Cool containing 328. Bounding for the 30th day of January 1787 the aforesaid parcel or part of the tract containing two hundred acres, in the same manorship on the west side of the tract including the plantation on said tract begining at a post oak corner there N. 65. E. to the waggon Road thence continuing N. along said waggon road to the upper line there S. 70. W. to a red Oak tree S. 42 W. 55. to a white Oak there S. 8. E. to a Stake there N. 65. E. 67. 50 to the Beginning Together with all and singular the rights hereditaments & appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said premises To have and To hold all the before mentioned parcel or part of said tract west side of waggon road two hundred acres (more or less) and I the said Edwards Watson do bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all the before mentioned premises clear of all incumbrances to the said Joseph M. Cool his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever In witness whereof I the said Edwards Watson have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 17th day of December one thousand eight hundred and four.
