


This Indenture made this tenth day of March one thousand seven hundred and ninety three, Between Ethy Meeks of South Carolina & Greenville County of the one part & Benjamin Brown of the same State and County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Ethy Meeks doth for and in consideration of the sum of fifty Pounds to him in hand well and truly paid at & before the sealing and Delivery of these presents by the said Benjamin Brown the Receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged Grant bargain sell alien Release and Confirm and by these presents Doth Grant bargain sell alien & Confirm unto him the said Benjamin Brown him his heirs & assigns forever all that part of a tract of Land Originally granted unto the said Ethy Meeks & Signed by Governor Moultrie on the 7th day of August 1786. for four hundred & Seventy Acres lying in the said County of Greenville & on a branch of Mountain Creek the water of Saluda River all that part of said Tract of Land

Beginning on a black Oak the Original Corner thence N.W. 70° thirty five chain to a post oak corner thence N.W. 15° fifty seven chain to a Stake Dudley's Corner thence N.E. 60° on Dudley's line to the corner a stake thence on the said Dudley's line running Eastwards so far as will include two hundred and fifty acres being marked off by a line of marked trees to the Original Line be the same more or less & being now in actual possession of him the said Benjamin Brown

Together with all and singular the trees, waters, hereditaments, rights, members & appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract or parcel of Land, and promises hereby bargain'd, sold, Belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion & reversions, remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof - To have and to hold the said parcel or tract of Land and promises with the & Every of the appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Brown him his heirs & assigns to his and to their only proper use and behoof absolute & forever - Lastly the said Ethy Meeks doth for himself & his heirs the said Tract of Land as above described unto the said Benjamin Brown him his heirs & assigns against all & every Person or Persons whatsoever shall & will warrant and forever defend, Witness my hand and seal this day & year first above written

 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Philip Sutherland of Greenville District State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred & Thirty Eight Dollars to me in hand paid by Jesse White of the District aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold & Released & By these presents Do Grant bargain sell & Release unto the said Jesse White a Plantation or Tract of Land Lying and being in the District aforesaid Beginning at an agreed Corner on John Macblere Line from thence to a post oak corner, on said M. Chere Line thence N. 84. E. 25. chain along said line to Persimmon corner thence S 25. E. 5 chain (to a P.O.)
