This Indenture made the Twenty first day of October in the year of our Lord  
one Thousand and Seven hundred and Ninety four. Between Jeremiah Chandler of  
the State of S<sup>t</sup>. Carolina and County of Greenville planter of the one part - and a Mervy  
Hall of the State & County aforesaid planter of the other part. Witneseth that the said  
Jeremiah Chandler for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty pounds Sterling to him in  
hand well and truly paid by the said Mervy Hall the receipt whereof is hereby fully —  
Acknowledged by the said Jeremiah Chandler, hath Granted bargained sold and by these  
presents Doth Grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, Convey, and, Confirm, unto the said Mervy  
Hall and to his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land Containing Two hundred  
and Ninety six Acres more or less - Situate lying and being in Greenville County, South  
Carolina & Washington District, on Brushy Creek waters of Tuckee river, the same being part  
of Two surveys one granted to Charles Eastie from under the hand of his Excellency  
William Moultrie Granted the fifth day of August 1793, the other granted to the  
said Jeremiah Chandler from under the hand of his Excellency Thomas Pinckney  
Granted the sixth day of October 1788, and the whole of one other Survey Containing  
One hundred acres granted to Robert Hammak by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq.  
the 6<sup>th</sup> of November 1786, Beginning on a post oak on the N. Side of Brush Creek  
on the said Chandlers Survey running from thence S<sup>o</sup>. 13. West 12. ch<sup>l</sup>. to a post oak  
3<sup>t</sup> thence S<sup>o</sup>. 5 W. crossing Brush Creek to a Stake on the original line, thence on the said  
Line S<sup>o</sup>. 71. E. 9 chain to a pine 3<sup>t</sup> thence S<sup>o</sup>. 40. W. 32. 25 on a small path to a black  
Jack 3<sup>t</sup> thence S<sup>o</sup>. 80. E. 23. chain to a Stake thence N<sup>o</sup>. 63 E 39. 50 to a black Jack thence  
N<sup>o</sup>. 19. W. 25 ch<sup>l</sup>. to a Stake 3<sup>t</sup> thence N<sup>o</sup>. 55 E. 20 ch<sup>l</sup>. to a Stake 3<sup>t</sup> thence N<sup>o</sup>. 35. W. 34. ch<sup>l</sup>  
to a post oak 3<sup>t</sup> thence S<sup>o</sup>. 40. W. 9 ch<sup>l</sup>. to a post oak 3<sup>t</sup> thence S<sup>o</sup>. 69. W. 32. ch<sup>l</sup>. to the Beginning  
Containing Two hundred and Ninety six acres more or less - Together with all and singular  
the trees Woods Waters, water Courses, Houses fences, profits & appurtenances whatsoever  
thereunto belonging or in any ways appertaining & also the reversion & revertions remain-  
der & remainders rents issues & profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof (To have)
