

M. Elanahan otherwise called Captain John M. Elanahan of the District of State
 aforesaid, HAVE granted bargained sold & released and by these presents Do grant
 Bargain sell and release unto the said John M. Elanahan his heirs and assigns
 all that tract or parcel of Land wherein I now live situated in the District of Greenville
 on the east side of Saluda River at the Confluence of the north & main forks of
 the said River. & Containing in the whole three hundred and forty Six Acres, be the
 same more or less, two hundred acres of which was Originally granted to Alex^r
 McElhaney and from him Conveyed to William D. Thomas and from Thomas to John
 Mottow and from Mottow to said Steegall and Bounded as follows Viz -
 Beginning on a white oak on the Bank of Saluda River running thence across the
 north fork of Saluda E^E 44^{ch} Chains 75. links to a Spanish Oak thence S^S 63. chains to a
 red oak thence West 28 chains to a Stake on the main Saluda as thence up the meanders of
 the same to the Beginning. Also thirty three acres of which being part of a tract of
 454^{acres} Originally granted to Thomas Hooper and from him conveyed to me the
 16th day of March 1801. Beginning on a red oak a conditional corner thence North
 28. West Cropping a creek forty three chains to a Stake by a small pine on said Steegall's
 line thence South Cropping said Creek thirty two chains 50 links to a white oak
 thence South Seventy five degrees East twenty chains 475. links to the Beginning -
 and one hundred and forty six acres of which was Originally granted to John Mottow
 and from him conveyed to me, being bounded as follows, Beginning on a Stake on
 Saluda River thence East 28 ch^l to a red oak thence North 9^{ch} 50. to a white oak
 thence S^S 76. East 30 ch^l to a hickory thence S^S 14. W^W 43 ch^l to a red oak thence N^N 35
 W^W 17. ch^l to a post oak thence N^N 73. W^W 14 ch^l to a Spanish oak on Saluda River
 thence up the meanders of said river to the beginning, out of which last mentioned
 tract I do except thirty three acres of Land adjoining Thos. Hooper's lands which
 I have sold & Conveyed to the said Hooper as may appear on record in the Office
 of Greenville in book G. page 73 R.C. in view of a tract of thirty three acres above
 recited. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments &
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
 ing to have and to hold, all and singular the premises above mentioned unto
 the said John M. Elanahan his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind
 myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the before mentioned unto the said John M. Elanahan his
 heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand
