For and in consideration of Four hundred dollars I do assign over my right of the within mentioned negro woman, and a child of hers named Amos to George W. Earle of Greenville District Sth Carolina. Witness my hands & this 2nd Dec^r 1805.

Know all men by these presents that I Sterling Ingram of the District and State aforesaid. in consideration of Four hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by George W. Earle of the same place have bargained sold & Delivered unto the said George W. Earle one negro woman of the age of about twenty five years named Lucy and her child named Amos. of about eighteen months old which said Negroes together with the Increase of the said Lucy. I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend unto the said Geo. W. Earle his heirs & assigns against myself my and every other person or persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same. Also that the said bargained property is free and clear of all manners of Sales, Judgments mortgages entails or other incumbrances whatsoever - -
