hundred & five, I know all men by these presents, that I Thomas Bowers of the State &
District aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to him in
hand paid by Samuel Sentry of the State & District aforesaid, Witnesseth that I
have granted bargained sold & Released & delivered & by these presents do grant
bargain sell release & deliver unto the said Samuel Sentry a certain tract or parcel
of lands, situated lying & being on both sides of the sixth hole fork of Sugar River having
such shapes & courses as follows (VIZ), Beginning on a Spanish Oak 34 then along a
conditional line to a hickory 34 on Walter Burrell line thence South East open line
to stake 34 thence north west to a white oak 34 thence East to the Beginning corner.
The rights & members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise Belonging or appertaining thereto, to have & to hold
all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Sentry
heirs & assigns forever & I the said Thomas Bowers do hereby bind myself my
heirs & assigns to warrant and forever defende all & singular the said premises
unto the said Samuel Sentry his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & assigns
& from all & every other person or persons whatsoever laying any lawful claim
to the said premises under me or mine or any person or persons. — I do Witness where
