State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I James Lin
of the State of North Carolina & Buncombe County for & in consideration of the
Sixty Six Dollars to me in hand paid by James Morton of the State of South Carolina
Greenville District, I have granted Bargained & Sold & by these presents do Grant
Bargain sell & release unto the S: James Station all that Plantation or tract of
Land, containing fifty acres be the same more or less, Beginning on a post oak and
running N. 15. E. 45. to a red oak thence N. 55. E. 60. William Alexander's line from that
along Alexander's line to his Beginning corner thence S. 10. W. to a Creek Husbts line
thence N. 35. W. to red oak corner thence S. 55. W. 24. to a post oak thence S. 15.
W. 33. to a post oak from thence to the Beginning, it being part of a tract of lands
originally granted to John Peden containing one thousand seven hundred and
fifty nine acres & duly conveyed to S: James Lin, reference being had to the
original grant will more fully appear, Together with all singular the rights mem-
bers her dittaments and appurtenances the said premises belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining to have and to hold all singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said James Morton his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
executors and administrators to forever warrant & defend the above described premises unto the said
James Morton his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever, against me & my heirs and
against every person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same by from or under me a any Person
