Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin West of the State of South Carolina: & District of Greenville for & in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by James Benson of the State of District afores^d. Have Granted bargained sold and Released unto the afores^d James Benson a plantation a tract of Land lying in the district afores^d on both sides of Tygar river on which said West now lives - Beginning on a white oak corner of Rays thence to a pine of said Bensons lands thence to a red oak of Woods Line thence Salmon line go links thence crossing the river to the Wagon Road & thence up the said Road to a line between Whealy & Stewards to rays South post oak corner thence to the beginning corner - Containing one hundred and twenty five acres more or less. Together with all the rights and appurtenances. To have and to hold all the premises before mentioned unto the said James Benson his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators & assigns to warrant and forever defend the aforesaid premises against all Person or Persons in any way claiming the said premises or any part thereof - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hands and affixed my seal this seventeenth day of November Eighteen hundred and five & in the Presence of us the Witnesses
