State of South Carolina, Know all men by these Presents that I Joseph Callaway of Greenville District, and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by William Grant sonⁿ of the District afores^d the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Grant his heirs and assigns forever one tract of land containing one hundred and eleven acres or the same more or less, situate in Greenville District, State aforesaid, lying on the north side of the south fork of Tygar river joining lands laid out for Randolph Casey, which said one hundred and eleven acres of land, originally granted to Levy Casey by a certain grant bearing date the fifth day of Feb^r. one thousand and eighty seven and by the said Levy Casey Conveyed to John Stanford jun^r and Sarah Stanford Conveyed the said land to Joseph Callaway, Beginning on a stake running N. 70° E. 37' to a black oak tree N. 17° W. 40' to a white oak tree S. 70° W. 30', thence S. 70° E. 40' thence to the Beginning point, Together with all and singular the woods, waters, water courses, buildings, property fixtures, appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident to or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Grant his heirs & assigns, forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Grant his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming to claim the same or any part thereof, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this eighth of June & in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five — and in the twenty ninth year of
