This Indenture made this eighteenth day of February in the year 377 of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & six, Between William Whorton of the State of South Carolina & District of Greenville of the one part: and William Chandler of the said State & District, of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William Whorton for and in consideration of the sum of thirty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said William Chandler, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said William Whorton hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said William Chandler a certain tract or piece of land lying and being in Greenville District on both sides of Mountain Creek of Enoree river said tract containing one hundred acres be the same more or less, it being part of a tract of land of three hundred acres originally granted to Wardworth, Beginning on a post oak perhaps one hundred yards on the East side of the waggon road that leads to Mr. Griffins, and on the most northern line of William Whorton's lands, from thence to run a direct South East course to the most Southern line of said lands, thence with said line to a red oak William Chandler comes thence with William Chandler's line to the northern line thence of, thence to the Beginning which said tract of land, of one hundred acres more or less, with all & every of its appurtenances, the said William Whorton doth from himself & his heirs and assigns all and every other person and Person my will warrant and forever defend to the said William Chandler his heirs and assigns forever, In Witness whereof the said William Whorton hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day & year above written
