Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the s^d premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ignatius Stokes his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators To warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Ignatius Stokes his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs and against every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any Part thereof - Witness my hands and seal this 24th day of January in the year 1806 and in the thirtieth year of the American Independence - Signed sealed & Acknowledged in Presence N.B.
