State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Daniel Kelly of Greenville district state aforesaid, for & in consideration of the just sum of Four hundred dollars come in hand paid by Patrick Moore, of the district state aforesaid have bargained sold & Relented, and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Patrick Moore all that tract or parcel of land, containing two hundred acres, situate in the above mentioned District, to W^t, bounding North on Bevordam Creek branch of Enoree river Pic^r Mountain, Beginning on said creek joining Crook Branch Land, thence to post Oak C. & thence to post Oak C. & thence to Stake C. & thence N.E. to post oak C. & thence to big Oak C. & thence N.E. to pine C. & thence W. to land laid out Benjamin Whortor there on said Whortors line S. twenty E. to said Bevordam Creek thence down the one end of S. Creek to the Beginning part being a grant originally granted to Obediah Hooper & part of a grant originally granted to Eliz^r Young the wife of George Salmon, including all within the above mentioned boundaries the same more or less.

Togethers with all and singular the rights numbers hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Patrick Moore his heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Patrick Moore his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
