ber 1801: John Townsend came before me & laid on his oath that he was present and did
see Joseph Laws & Tabetha Laws his wife sign & as their act & did witness the written
deed of conveyance to Benjamin Townsend for the use and purpose therein men-
tioned and that he and George Thomas with himself subscribe their names as
witnesses to the same - Sworn to and Subscribed the day & date above written -

Recorded the 5th day of May 1806

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The State of South Carolina. I know all men by these presents that I John M. Troy Jr. of the District of Greenville & State aforesaid for in consideration of the sum of one thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Townsend the Recit whom is hereby fully acknowledged Have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Benjamin Townsend his heirs Executors and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate in the State & District above mentioned on the waters of Reedy River & Reedy fork containing five hundred & forty six acres be the same more or less being part of two tracts the one originally granted to John Clark Kilpatrick & Signia by His Excellency William Moultrie on the 1st day of June 1786: The other to James Jordan on the 1st day of August 1786. By the said Wm Moultrie Begining on a red oak tree S.W. 88: 80: 00: to a post oak ~~on~~ on John Hughes Lands, thence S.E. 8. 68. to a stake & on Tidals line a thence N.E. 88: 85. to a stake & on John M. Troy's Junr. Lands thence to the Begining so as to include a small angle of the last mentioned tract. Granted to Jordan not contained in the lines above described as by a reference to plat thereof, annexed to the original grants, will more fully appear To HAVE and To Hold: all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said Townsend, his heirs & assigns, Executors & Administrators in fee simple forever. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the said Benjamin Townsend his heirs & assigns etc. to his, or their proper use & behove forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all the premises before mentioned with their appurtenance to the said Benjamin Townsend, his, heirs, assigns, Executors etc. against myself & my heirs & assigns against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this eighteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen in the presence of the Subscripting of the united States the Thirtieth —
