 consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty Dollars Paid by Hewlet Sullivan the  
 Rec'd whereof is hereby fully acknowledged. HAVE granted bargained sold & Released in  
 Delivered & by these Presents do grant bargain sell & Deliver unto the said Hewlet Sullivan  
 all that tract or parcel of land lying & being in the State & District aforesaid on Reedy river  
 Containing Two hundred and twenty nine acres being the same more or less Beginning on  
 Reedy River on a gum tree thence by a line of marked trees SW. 44. 27. to a white oak 3x  
 on a branch called Poplar bottom Branch thence up the said Branch 240 ft to an  
 ash 3x thence up a small branch running into the said Ash 14<sup>th</sup> to a Hickory 3x  
 thence west 8 ch. 50. L. to a chestnut 3x thence SW. 20. 9. 50 to a red oak stump 3x  
 thence N.E. 70. 19. to a red oak 3x thence S.E. 55. 17. 50. to a Post Oak 3x thence  
 N.E. 55. 39. 50. to a red oak on Reedy River thence up the same to the Beginning  
 with its meanders Being part of several Tracts of land granted to John Winn July  
 15<sup>th</sup> 1784: another to Hewlet Sullivan & to Mary Barnes Bounded North & E. N.W.  
 on William Kelly land, S.W. & South on the said Sullivan's lands & S.E. & N.E. on Hudson  
 Berry's land and Reedy River - Together with all and singular the rights, members  
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining  
 To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
 Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever, And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs  
 Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all the Premises before mentioned  
 for ourselves and our heirs & against all Persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same

 day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & five
