State of South Carolina Greenville District, This Indenture made this 5th day of January in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & Six, Between Beverly Borroum of the district of Greenville & State of South Carolina aforesaid of the one Part and Tobias Philips of the same District, and State of the other Part, Witnesseth that the said Tobias Philips, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Borroum have mortgaged unto the said Beverly Borroum his heirs & assigns The following Property - Two cows and calves one bed and furniture & one crib of corn which said Property the said Tobias Philips mortgages unto the said Borroum in virtue of having had & Received of the said Borroum the said sum of Sixty Dollars the said Philips having the Equity of Redemption that is to say, paying & discharging the said sum of Sixty Dollars on or before the last day of May next with all lawfull charges with Interest from the date of these Presents then this Instrument and agreement to be void or Else to the Fore closure of this Mortgage to be carried into Effect.
