 post oak, thence S. 50. E. 36.50^{ch} to a lightwood stake thence S. 40 N. 38.50^{ch} to a stake on Mrs
 Woods Line thence with his line to the Beginning containing by Estimation one hundred acres
 be the same more or less, the same part of the ^{same} tract of land containing 1542
 Acres granted to Maj: Parsons by Patent bearing date 2nd day of June 1788, & by him
 conveyed to me, Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, To have and To hold the above menti-
