E. to the River - thence up the meanders of the said River, to the Beginning the same containing fifty acres more or less, and I do hereby warrant and forever defend the aforesaid tract or Parcel of lands to the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against the claims or claims of all and every other person or persons whomsoever, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal affixed my Seal the day and year first above written " Signa Seala and do and delivered in the presence of us -
