Know all men by these presents that I Albert Robins of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of one hundred & eighty eight Dollars to me in hand paid by Christopher Robins of the district aforesaid. Have granted bargain sold & Released & by these presents do Grant bargain sell & Release unto Christopher Robins Part of two tracts of lands, the one Originally granted to Robert Ramsey on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1786. The other being granted to Jesse Green on the third day of August 1801. Situate & lying in the district aforesaid; on the branches of Reedy River, containing one hundred acres more or less. Beginning on a post oak corner 34 on a dividing line between said Robins & Baruths land running thence N. 17. 00. to a pine corner thence N. 7. W. N. 50. to a white o corner 34 thence N. 22. 17. 00. to a post oak corner, thence S. 36. W. to a black Jack corner thence S. 45. W. 27. 50. to a post oak corner, thence S. 45. E. 20. to a red oak corner, thence S. 4 = East to a black oak corner, thence S. 76. E. to the Beginning corner, With all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Christopher Robins his heirs & assigns forever. And I do bind myself and my Executors to warrant and forever defend the said premises above mentioned unto the said Christopher Robins his heirs & assigns & against myself my heirs & against every person or persons whatsover claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
