

Know all men by these presents that I John Stanfor & Sen^r of the State and district aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty pounds to him in hand paid by James Daugherty of the State and district aforesaid WITNESSETH that I have granted bargained sold released and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell release and deliver unto the said James Daugherty a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and sixty acres situate lying and being in Greenville District on the south fork of Tyger River, Begining at a black oak running North 28° 00' = 22° 50' to a black oak thence N. 47° 00' 40' to a stake thence N. 40' E. 10' to a chestnut tree S. 40' E. 30' to a Spanish oak thence S. 10' E. 35' to a white oak thence S. 50' W. 10' to the Beginning corner Containing the above number of acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights and members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise belonging or appertaining therunto To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Daugherty himself his heirs and assigns forever, and I the said John Stanfor Sen^r do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and a forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Daugherty himself his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and from all and every person or persons whatsoever laying any lawfull claim to the said premises under me or mine or any other person or persons whatsoever, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 17th of Feb^r in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Six, Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of us Thomas Barton Jun^r } — Adam Marley } — C.W.
