

The State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I Reuben Sims of Newberry District in the State aforesaid for the sum of Two Thousand dollars paid by Samuel Earle of Pendleton District in the State above mentioned, The Recpt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant bargain ~~and~~ sell and Release unto the said Samuel Earle his heirs & assigns all that tract or plantation of land lying in the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid on both sides of the north fork of Saluda River, bounded by lines running S. 39° E. 86th. on Tho. M. Carroll's land thence N. 39° E. 12th. thence N. 87° W. 6th. on Geo. Salmon's land thence N. 3° E. 45° 50' to Red Oak tree thence N. 32° W. 7° 50' to a post 84. 31. thence S. 58° W. 70' to a post Oak 34 the begining corner. Being a tract of six hundred and forty acres Originally granted to John Jackson and signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the seventh day of November 1785. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before described, except a small part ceded to Thomas M. Carroll which will appear on Record in the Register's office in Greenville District to the said Earle his heirs and assigns forever, Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs to warrant & forever defend the premises before mentioned unto the said Earle his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and assigns, and against every person or persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
