State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I Enoch Benson of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and a fifty dollars paid by Charles Bruce Junr. of Greenville District and State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and Released & by these presents do, Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Charles Bruce Junr. all that tract plantation & parcel of land supposed to contain Two hundred acres be the same more or less, situate in Greenville District aforesaid, on the waters of Clearcreek & Shoal fork of Clear creek they being waters of South Sygar River, Beginning on a maple at the branch called Cains branch running East to a post oak corner thence S. 30. E. 35. chain to a Black oak thence S. 62. E. 29. chain to a stake thence N. 28. E. 37 chain to a Black oak, thence N. 52. W. 25 chain to a chestnut thence N. 32. E. 49. chain to a post Oak thence N. 48. E. 11. chain to a post oak, thence N. 82. W. 28. chain to a Stake thence S. 27. W. 39. chain to a Stake, thence thence N. 82. W. 21 chain 50 links to a Stake thence a straight line to where the road leading from Capt. Thomas's to Greenville Courthouse crosses Cains branch, thence up the branch to the Beginning - Together with all and singular the rights members & appurtenances and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appurtenant

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
