This Indenture made the twenty ninth day of December in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one. between William Floid of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part. and William Mullican of the County & State aforesaid of the other Part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Sterling money to the said William Floid in hand paid by the said William Mullican at and before the sealing and Delivery of these presents the receipt and Payment whereof is hereby acknowledged and therefore doth release acquit and discharge the said William Mullican his heirs Executors and administrators by these presents the said William Floid hath granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said William Mullican and to his heirs and assigns forever. a certain tract or parcel of lands situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid. Beginning at a Stake Mullicans Corner. Runs North 6<sup>th</sup> E. 34 poles to a Stake thence S 86<sup>th</sup> E. 239 poles to a Hickay Bush thence S. 6<sup>th</sup> W. 34 poles to a Hickay Saplin an old corner thence with the old line to the Beginning Containing fifty acres more or less. it being part of a tract of land of six hundred and forty acres part of the land that the said Floid now lives on, and all Houses building orchards ways waters profits Commodities Perquisites and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises is hereby granted or any part thereof. belonging or in any wise appertaining. and the Reversions and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents issues and profits thereof. and also all the Estate and Estate Right Title Interest use trust Property Claim & Demands whatsoever of him the said William Floid of in and to the said premises and all deeds evidences and writings touching or in any wise concerning the same. To Have and To Hold the said lands hereby conveyed and all and singular other the Premises hereby bargained and sold every part and parcel thereof with this and every of their appurtenances unto the said William Mullican his heirs & assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Mullican his heirs and assigns forever and the said William Floid for himself his heirs Executors Administrators doth hereby Promise Covenant and agree that he the said William Floid his heirs Executors and Administrators shall and will at all times warrant and forever defend the said premises to the said William Mullican
