I know all men by these presents that I Elias Earle of Greenville District, & State aforesaid, in consideration of One hundred Dollars to me Paid by Robert S. C. Foster & James S. C. Foster of the state aforesaid, Have granted bargained and sold & by these Presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Robert & James Foster all that, or Part of Land, Situate in said District on the waters of the main branch of the North fork of Saluda Beginning on a Poplar on a branch of the middle fork running N^o 40. East 4 chains to a poplar on a branch to another poplar thence S^o 74. E^o 24 chain to 50 links to a stake thence N^o 64. E^o 66^m 25 links to a white oak, thence N^o 7. West 22. Chain 30 links to a stake thence N^o 65. E^o 3. Chain 410 links to a chestnut, thence N^o 12. East 9 chain 50 links to a red oak N^o 42. West 5 chains to a red oak N^o 81. West 24 chains 50 links to a lightwood Stake. S^o 18. W. 9. chain 60 links to a red oak N^o 88. E^o 2 chains 50 links to a pine stump S^o 67. W^o 19. 20. to a chestnut oak S^o 76. West 12 chain to the begining. Computed to be one hundred and fifty acres more or less.
