Saw the same - Sworn to the 28th of September 1802. Thomas Ferguson J.P.

[Recorded the 22nd day of May 1807]

This Indenture made the twenty eighth day of September in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and two, and in the twenty sixth year of America's Independence between William Edwards of the State of South Carolina Greenville District of the one part. and Warren Mapsey of the other part. of said State & District. Witnesseth that the said William Edwards for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seventy five Dollars to me in hand paid doth bargain sell unto the said Warren Mapsey a certain plantation or tract of land containing sixty acres more or less. Lying on the south side of Cain brack branch of the Encoee River. Beginning on a white oak on said branch on or near Henry Benson's line running up said branch to Walter Jacobs line from thence on said line to Joseph Edwards line from thence on said line down to said Benson's line from thence on said line to the Beginning. it being part of a tract granted to Arrow Kemp in the year one thousand seven hundred and eighty five - together with all and singular the buildings orchards wood and waters & all the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto. Have and To Hold the said tract of lands, unto the said Warren Mapsey his heirs forever, and he the said Edwards do warrant and defend from him and his heirs to the said Mapsey the above mentioned premises or from any others laying a lawfull claim thereto. Know all men by these Presents that I Ignatius Stokes of Union District in the State aforesaid Planter in consideration of four hundred dollars to me paid by David McCoy of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid Planter have granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said David McCoy All that tract of lands containing two hundred acres the same more or less, lying in Greenville District, on the East side of the North fork of Saluda river being part of a tract of land originally granted to William McHenry lying to the west of Abner Benson's land, Baylis Earles land Thomas St. Carrolls land & said River.
