David his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and defend, defend all and singular the said Negroes above mentioned to the said Jonathan M. David his heirs and assigns forever against myself and my heirs and against every other Person whomsoever lawfully Claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
