Thomas (the Elder) of the State and district aforesaid, have granted bargained sold
and Released by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said
John Thomas all that tract or Parcel of land, Containing forty seven acres (be the same
more or less), being part of a tract of ninety two acres of land to the said W^m. D. Thomas
situate in the District aforesaid, on branches of South Tyger river, between two tracts of
land belonging to the said John Thomas, Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Forty seven acres of land belonging
or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and To Hold all singular the
Premises before mentioned unto the said John Thomas his heirs and assigns forever —
And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the above named Premises unto the said John
Thomas his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every other
Person or Persons (in or thro: us) any part or parcel thereof. Witness my hand &
Seal this nineteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred seven and in the thirty first year of American Independence
