& State aforesaid, Farmer, I have Granted bargained sold and Released, and by these  
Presents Do Grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Thomas Avary part of a  
tract of land originally granted to Benjamin Arnold for two hundred & twenty acres,  
then Conveyed from Arnold to Charles Avary Senior then to Thomas Avary - Beginning  
on Ann Browns Pine, comes 34 thence along anor Browns line to the north fork of  
Mountain Creek, thence down the meanders of sc creek Humphrey Cobb's to a white oak  
34. thence North 56. W. thence Philip Anthony's line to a red oak 34 thence P. Anthony  
line, S. 34. W. to a red oak 34, thence N. 50. W. to a stake 34. Samuel Williams line, to a  
Red. on the south fork of mountain creek, thence a conditional line to the begin-  
ning pine corners, including thirty six acres more or less. Together with all and  
singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises  
belonging or in any wise incident or Appertaining - To Have and To Hold all and  
singular the Premises before mentioned, to the said Thomas Avary his heirs and  
assigns forever - and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators
