Beginning on a post oak 3<sup>d</sup> running thence S 9<sup>d</sup> W. 61. 50. to a Stake 3<sup>d</sup> Patrick's Lafferty's land. thence N. 89. W. 36. on William Woods line to a red oak 3<sup>d</sup> thence S. 20. W. 18. 25. to a post oak 3<sup>d</sup> thence on Henrich Arnold line N. 57. W. 14. 50. to a Stake 3<sup>d</sup> thence on Samuel Nabors line N. 65. E. 12. 50. to a post oak 3<sup>d</sup> thence N. 40. E. 30. to a post oak 3<sup>d</sup> on said Nabors line thence N. 70. E. 19. 50. to a hickory 3<sup>d</sup> thence on said Nabors line N. 20. E. to a hickory 3<sup>d</sup> thence N. 66.
