Nabors of Greenville District and State aforesaid, I have granted bargained sold & Released and by these
Presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto the said Samuel Nabors all that plantation or tract of
land, containing one hundred and fifty two acres, be the same more or less, Situate in this District
of Greenville laying on the waters of mountain creek. Beginning on a post oak 3^t running thence S^Eg
W. 6^E. 50. to a Stake 3^t. Patrick Lafferty's land. thence E. 89. W. 36. on William Woods line to a red oak 3^t
thence S. 20. W. 18. 25. to a post oak 3^t thence on Hendrick Arnold line N. 57. W. 14. 50 to a Stake 3^t
thence on Samuel Nabors line N. 65. E. 12. 50 to a post oak 3^t thence E. 40. E. 30. to a post oak 3^t
on said Nabors line thence N. 70. E. 19. 50. to a hickory 3^t thence on said Nabors line N. 20. E. to a
hickory 3^t thence N. 66. E. 28. 40. the beginning corner. Being a tract of land granted to William
