I know all men by these presents that I James Tubb of Greenville District, and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by Salathiel Clements of the State and district aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted bargained sold and released, and by the presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Salathiel Clement his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less, situate in Greenville District on bank of the North fork of Saluda river & Reedy river & runs as follows (viz) Beginning at a red oak corner thence along the original line to a pine corner thence along the said line to a conditional corner on a post oak, thence to a conditional pine corner on Bell's land, thence running a straight line from the pine to a marked red oak tree marked by James Fisher & Cornelius Cooksey thence along the old original line to the Beginning of the said line bounded on Garavys land, Together with all and singular the rights, members, tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Salathiel Clements his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors & adm^r to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Salathiel Clements his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & against all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
