that I James Nicoll of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of Twenty  
dollars to me in hand by James Cox of the same District, Have granted  
conveyance & sold and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell & release unto  
unto the said James Cox one certain tract or parcel of land, containing by  
Estimation forty acres more or less, situate in the district aforesaid on musk  
Creek (waters of Sugar river, & bounded as follows, Viz, Beginning on a post oak  
in S<sup>r</sup> Cox's plantation thence with the original line S. 20 W. to S<sup>r</sup> Musk Creek  
thence across the same as it meanders to the mouth of a branch call'd  
Murphy's branch, thence up the same to line call'd Murphy's line, with  
S<sup>r</sup> line to a red oak corner on the road that leads from S<sup>r</sup> Cox's to S<sup>r</sup> Nicoll's  
Mill thence a new line N. 20. W. till it intersects with the original line thence  
with said line south to the beginning, Being part of tract of land originally granted  
John Nicoll Sen<sup>r</sup>, Together with all and singular the rights members, Heredita-  
ments, Appurtenances, to S<sup>r</sup> premises belonging or in any wise incident or  
appertaining, To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said James Cox his heirs & assigns forever, And I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs Executors & admors to warrant & forever defend all & singular the  
S<sup>r</sup> premises unto the said S<sup>r</sup> Cox his heirs & assigns, against myself my heirs or  
any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part thereof
