and assigns, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Exors. & admors to warrant &
for ever defend all and singularly the premises before mentioned unto the said
Eli Baldwin his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against
every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
