


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I HAVE granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Jesse Framell a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the district of said Begining on a white oak corner on the S^o Bank of Wery Creek waters of N. Saluda thence S^o to a N. corner thence E to the top of the ridge then the ridge the line to the original line thence N. to Bruce's line, thence N. E. to B. Gum corner thence N. to a p. o. corner thence W. to a Shoal on a branch thence across the ridge then down the ridge to the Creek, the creek the line to the Begining corner, to contain 250 acres be the same more or less. I do hereby warrant and forever defend the same from me my heirs Executors, admors and assigns and from every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand this 18th day of March 1807. 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This Indenture made this 15th day February of in this year Eighteen hundred & Eight, between Harmon Gibson of the one part, & Jesse Framell of the other part: both of the State of South Carolina, and district of Greenville, Witnesseth that the s^d Harmon Gibson for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars, to him in hand well and truly paid, at & before the signing and delivering of these presents, hath bargained granted and sold and by ^{virtue of,} these presents doth bargain grant & sell unto the above s^d Jesse Framell his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land, containing ninety six acres, situated in the State and district afores^d: on the north side of the north fork of Saluda river and on the small branches of the same, Having such shape and marks as is represented by a plat annexed to a grant originally granted to John Forrest by his Excellency David Reedledge bearing date the third day of June one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine, and recorded in Grant book J. N^o 5. page 272: Begining at a red oak and running North 13. W. 26. 50 to a red oak thence S. 77. W. 33. to a red oak thence S. 33. W. 4. 50 to a Stake, thence S. 20. E. 12. 50. to a B. Gum thence S. 63. E. 49. 50. to a Stake, thence N. 15. 50. to the Begining corner, To Have & To Hold the s^d tract or parcel of land & premises
