No State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that we William
Pollard and Benjamin Pollard Junr. of the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to us in hand paid by
George Bain of the district and State aforesaid, have granted bargained and
released, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto
unto the said George Bain a plantation or tract of land containing one
hundred and fifty acres of land more or less, lying in Greenville district
on a branch of Reedy River, the south side, Beginning on a stake corner
on the original line, thence running N. 65. W. 40. 00. to a post oak corner thence N. 25.
E. to a chestnut corner thence to Samford Spring branch thence down the spring
branch to Mary Samford line thence along the said Samford line to a red oak
corner on Frederick Croft line thence along the said line to a stake conditional
corner on the said croft line near an old post oak thence along a conditional
line agreed on by the said William Pollard & Jacob Croft to a stake corner on the
original line then along the original line to the Beginning; being part granted to
William Watty and signed by his excellency William Moultrie on the fifth day of
February 1787. and part granted to David Veslett and signed Governor Pinckney
on the third day of November 1788. and part granted to Benjamin Pollard Junr. and
signed by Paul Hamilton on the 19th day of November 1805: as by the plat annexed
to the said grants will more fully appear, together with all and
singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
