year, she last Spring a star in her face and a spot on her nose, a white or
grey spot on her near arm, trot, and I do bind myself my heirs
Executor and administrators to warrant and forever defend the said
mare unto the said Mary Rodden her heirs and assigns against myself
my heirs Executor and administrators and against all and every person or
persons whomsoever laying any lawfull claim thereto —
