Beginning on a chestnut oak by a large Rock running thence N. 70. W. 54. E. 77 Links to a chestnut corner thence S. 20. W. 18. 20 to a conditionally stake corner thence S. 70. E. 54. 77: to a stake corner on the other side near Daniel Caughteys corner thence N. 20. E. 18. 20. to the beginning chestnut oak corner: containing one hundred acres more or less, the same being a part of a three hundred acre tract of Land granted to Patrick Shaw on the 25th day of January 1780 and by the said Shaw sold and conveyed to Joseph Pile Sen^r and by the said Joseph Pile the above part sold and conveyed unto Joseph Pile Jun^r.
