Jimi now in the possession of Henry Parry, Fanny his wife, Lewis, Peggy, and Eddy her three children together with her future increase. which said negroes I do hereby warrant and forever will defend the title of to the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty first day of April one thousand eight hundred and six
