State of S. Carolina Greenville County, This Indenture made this fourth day  
of September one thousand seven hundred and ninety five, and in  
Nineteenth year of the sovereignty and Independence of America  
between Frederick Brock of the one part, & Benjamin Raglin of the other  
part both of the State and County aforesaid, Witnesseth that for and in  
consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling money  
Paid to the said Frederick Brock by the said Frederick Brock both  
granted sold Aliened and confirmed unto the said Benjamin Raglin  
two hundred and nine acres of land it being part of a tract of land  
originally granted unto James M. Roy containing three hundred and  
seven acres granted by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq. Governor and  
commander in chief in and over the State aforesaid, bearing date the fifth  
day of June one thousand seven hundred and eighty six, and Recorded in  
grant book L L L conveyed by deed of conveyance from said James M. Roy to Frederick  
Brock bearing the 21<sup>st</sup> of Feb. 1791. said tract of two hundred and nine  
acres lying in S. County on the waters of Reedy River Cold Saunders  
Branch. on the north side of River, including the west side of Parises Mountain  
bounded on West on Samuel Magnefs, and hath such shape form & marks
