State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I William Stewart of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars paid by Robert Carter of the astrict aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert Carter all that tract or parcel of land supposed to contain twenty three acres be the same more or less, being a part of a tract granted to Samuel Hags and by him conveyed to William Stewart Jr. which said twenty three acres lying on the north side of clear creek of the south fork of Tygar River, Beginning on a black oak near the road, which is Carter's Langley & Robert Carter corner running thence the course of Langley line to a sweet gum in an old field then up the creek a conditional line to a black gum on the bank of the creek, then down the various courses of the creek to Jeremiah Bruce's line, then along said line to Robert Carter's line, then along Robert Carter's line to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert Carter his Heirs and assigns, forever, and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Exec<sup>t</sup> of adm<sup>r</sup> to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Robert Carter his Heirs and assigns, against myself and my Heirs, & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my Hand & Seal this 24<sup>th</sup> day of September AD one thousand Eight hundred and five, in the 30<sup>th</sup> year of the Independence of the united States of North America - Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of, James Duncan
