State and district aforesaid. I have granted bargained sold unto the s^d Aaron
Kemp a certain tract or parcel of land containing Sixty four acres, Situate in the
State and district aforesaid on both sides of Maple creek of Enoree river, Beginning
on a hickory ct. on the N^o Side of said creek. Runs N. 53. W. 17 to a dogwood 31 then
N. 25. E. on a dividing line between James Tate & said Kemp. 40 to a red oak 31
then S. 55. E. 17 to hickory 31 then S. 25. W. 40 to the Beginning, which includes Sixty
four acres. Together with all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments, and
appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining -
thereunto, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Ex^{ors} & adm^{ors} towards and forever
defend all and singular the above described premises unto the said Aaron Kemp
his heirs Ex^{ors} adm^{ors} and assigns forever, against myself my heirs Ex^{ors} & adm^{ors}
and no further. Witness my hand and seal this second day of April,

of Greenville District in the said State for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty
dollars to me in hand paid by John Stokes of the same place; Have granted bargained
sold and blessed and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said
John Stokes all that tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and eighty seven
acres, be the same more or less, Situate in the district & State aforesaid on Laurel creek
and waters thereof, being part of a tract of 600 acres of land originally granted to
David McDavid by his Excellency Charles Pinckney the 6th Feb^y 1792. being that part which
was conveyed from David McDavid to David Edwards - Beginning on a stake corner
on St. S. Sheltons line, Running thence N. 10. E. 38 to a pine, N. 55. W. 47. 50. to a stake
