I Have granted bargained sold unto the & Aaron Kemp a certain tract or parcel of land containing Sixty four acre, Situate in the State and district aforesaid on both sides of Maple creek of Enore river, Beginning on a hickory tree on the N<sup>o</sup>. Side of said creek Precisely N 53 W 17 to a dogwood tree then N 25 E on a dividing line between James Tate & Aaron Kemp. 40 to a red oak then S 55 E 17 to hickory 34 then S 25 W 40 to the Beginning, which includes Sixty four acres. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditamrty and appurtenancy thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exec<sup>t</sup> & adms<sup>r</sup> to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described premises unto the said Aaron Kemp his Heirs Exec<sup>t</sup> adms<sup>r</sup> and affug<sup>s</sup> forever, against myself my heirs Exec<sup>t</sup> & adms<sup>r</sup> and no further. Witness my hand and seal this second day of April.

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I David Edwards of Greenville District in the said State, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty dollars to me in hand paid by John Stokes of the same place, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents Do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Stokes all that tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and eighty seven acres, be the same more or less. Situate in the district & State aforesaid on Laurel creek and waters thereof, being part of a tract of 800 acres of land originally granted to David M. David by His Excellency Charles Pinckney the 6<sup>th</sup> Feby 1792. being that part which was conveyed from David M. David to David Edwards - Beginning on a state corner on Dr. N. Shettons line, running thence N. 10 E 38 to a pine, S. 53 W. 47 50. to a state
