 convey and confirm forever, to the said Thomas Ligon one certain tract or parcel of land  
 lying and being in the County of Halifax in the State of Virginia on the north side  
 of Dan River, and bounded as follows, Beginning at Browns Creek at the mouth of  
 the great Spring branch thence north thirty one Degrees west one hundred and Eight  
 Poles to a stump near the Swelling house thence North Eighty Six degrees west  
 forty poles to a pile or stake in the cleared ground, thence South five Degrees  
 West seventy four poles to pointers on the edge of an old field thence South  
 Sixty Eight Degrees west one hundred and twenty four poles to the bank of Wades  
 Creek thence down said Creek as it meanders to Dan River thence down said River  
 as it meanders to the mouth of Browns Creek, thence up said Creek as it meanders  
 to the Beginning — With all the priviledges and appurtenances thereto belonging or in  
 any wise appertaining. To Have and To Hold the hereby bargained Premises with all  
 the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Thomas Ligon his heirs and assigns forever  
 and I the said Blackman Ligon doth hereby for myself my heirs Executors administrators  
 or assigns warrant and forever defend a good and lawfull title of the hereby bargained  
 Premises with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining  
 to the said Thomas Ligon his heirs & assigns, In Whereof I have hereunto set
