I Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Green of the district of Greenville and State of South Carolina have bargained sold and delivered unto Archabalo Lester of the State and district aforesaid One feather bed \$30.00. House hold and kitchen furniture \$15. 1200 lb of Flour \$36. 16 head of hogs \$40. 6 head of Cows \$40. 80 barrels of Corn \$200 3000 lb of Cotton \$360. 1 waggon & gears \$100. 6000 feet of plank \$60. I bind myself my heirs Executrix & administrators to warrant and defend the said property forever from every Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the said property Received Nine hundred and fifty seven dollars & 50 cents in full. Sealed with my seal and dated this twenty fourth of October 1808 Test Sam'l McFrary
