the within deed to Rosa Garrett for the use & purpose therein mentioned

that I Jacob Swaffer of the State and district aforesaid, for and in consideration  
of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid by James Nicholas of the State  
and district aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Nicholas all that  
land or parcel of land containing two hundred acres more or less lying and  
being in the district & State, on the Long branch of South Tygar river, Beginning  
on a white oak on the branch thence up the S<sup>o</sup> branch to the head thereon  
W<sup>e</sup> on a conditional to a chestnut corner on Wilkersons line thence S<sup>e</sup> line  
to a post oak thence N<sup>W</sup> on S<sup>e</sup> Wilkersons line to a red oak thence N<sup>E</sup> to a jupl  
corner on the long branch thence down said branch to a black oak concluding  
a certain spring thence S<sup>E</sup> to a lightwood stake corner thence to a dead white  
oak corner on Wren's line, thence on Wren's line N<sup>E</sup> course to a conditional  
corner on S<sup>W</sup> line a black oak thence N<sup>W</sup> on a conditional line to the Beginning  
The above mentioned land being part of two surveys one granted to the said  
Swaffer the Eighth day of January 1798. the other part granted to Robert  
Rey the sixth day of April 1801. sufficient thence may be had from the  
plots of said land together with all and singular the rights members, hendi-  
taments and appurtenances to the S<sup>o</sup> premises, belonging or in any wise appertain-  
ing. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said James Nicholas his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself  
my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the S<sup>o</sup> premises unto the said James Nicholas his heirs and assigns against myself  
my heirs and against every other Person lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and affixed my seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one  
thousand eight hundred and six. Signed sealed and delivered in presence of
